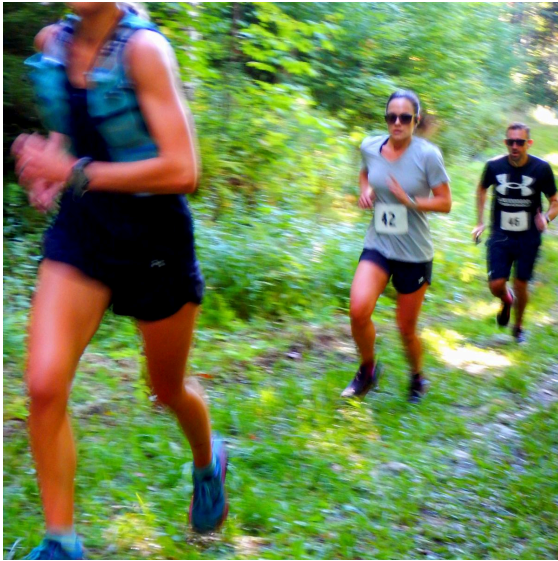
## TetraSki and SnowKart Programs back for 2026
