Registration for the **Stowe aMTB weekend** is now open. The event is on August 22-24 in Stowe, Vermont. The plan is to ride single tracks at Cady Hill Forest on Saturday, and participate in the Race to the Top of Vermont on the Sunday. If there is enough demand, we may add a short ride ride on the Friday afternoon.

We have booked and paid for a few campsites for all to share at the Goldbrook campground in Stowe (they know us and are always eager to help us out there.) We also have a few rooms reserved at the Commodores Inn. Give them a call to reserve your own room if camping is not your thing.) There are of course many other lodging options in Stowe, although it seems that camping together is one of the highlights of the weekend.

We are partnering with Adaptive Sports Partners again this year and will have very limited amount of e-assist mountain bikes available. We invite you to bring your own, or try and borrow one if you don't have your own. We are trying to partner with more programs who also have bikes, fingers crossed that's successful. I invite you to sign up asap, we need to place our orders for the jerseys by June 1st, AND space is limited. I will keep the event open as long as I can for those who have bikes or can find their own. The rest, know that I am working hard at finding bikes ;).
