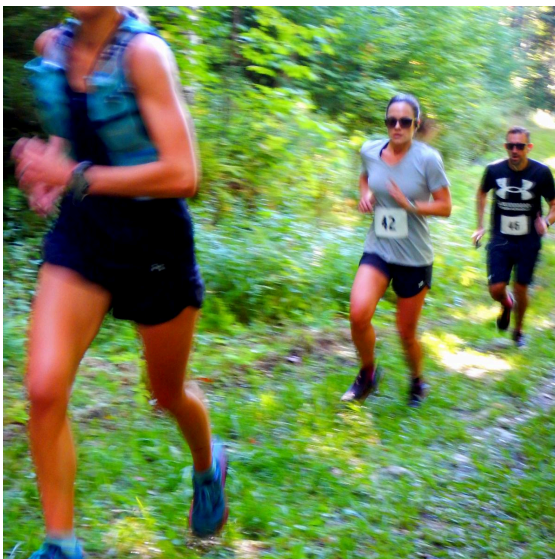

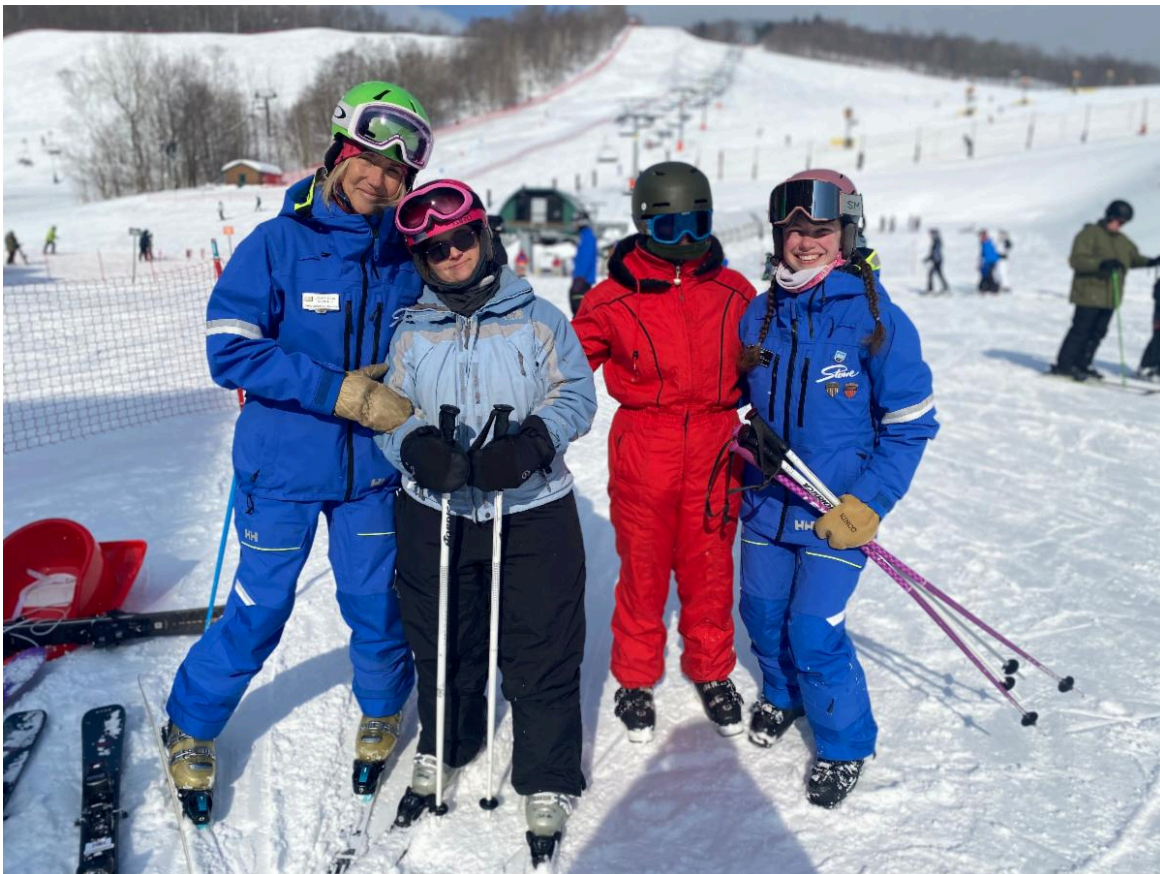


USTA New England All Comers Wheelchair Tennis Camp

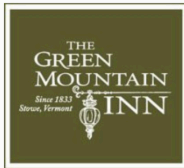
